Covid-19 Protocol Update

Thank you parents and guardians for working with us to keep our students and staff healthy and safe!

We are definitely seeing more student absences than we are used to, but that is because parents are following the public health guidelines and keeping students at home when they are exhibiting symptoms of Covid-19.

You must keep your child home if they are experiencing symptoms of illness.

Please keep in mind that if your child(ren) exhibit symptoms while at school, we adhere to public health guidelines that require the following:

- isolation of the student in a separate room
- parent/guardian will be called to pick up their child immediately-- no exceptions
- your child will remain in the isolation room until he/she is picked up

Please make sure that the information you provided on the emergency form is correct and up to date.

If you work a far distance from the school, it is important to have a plan in place should your child need to be picked up.

Before returning to school following an illness, a child must be fever free for 48 hours – without the help of medication. They must not exhibit acute symptoms for 24 hours (cough, runny nose, sore throat etc.) – without the help of medication.

End of Day Routine

If there is a change to the end of day routine for your child(ren), we ask that you inform the school by 12:00 pm on the day of the change. Please email the principal (acurry@wqsb.qc.ca) and your child(ren)'s teacher to alert them to the change. This is important for us to ensure that students are safe and accounted for. We will not allow children to board different buses or leave with a family member unless a parent/guardian has notified the school in advance.

Thank you for your co-operation.

POLTIMORE HOODIES: COMING SOON!


We are purchasing hoodies with our school logo for all of our students at **no cost** to families.
